



## Vendor/Booth Information

1. 10' x 10' Space provided per vendor.
2. **Fee is for space only. Vendor provides all tables, chairs, canopies, tents, etc.**
3. A limited number of spaces with electricity are available (provides first come, first serve.) There will be an additional \$25.00 for space with electricity.
4. Water is not provided.
5. Food vendors must have a **permit from the Cumberland County Health Department** (Contact Chrystal Warren at 856-327-7602 Ext. #1128)
6. **All vendors are responsible for the clean up at and around their space.** (trash cans provided)
7. Vendors should have insurance or sign the Booth Application Release Form. For more information regarding insurance, contact the office of Bridgeton Main Street at 856-453-8130 or 973-864-4001.
8. **Prohibited Items:** Items that are deemed a nuisance or a public safety concern will not be allowed. These items include but are not limited to: silly string, disappearing ink, hair spray coloring, plastic weapons, snap pops, poppers, fake cigarettes, stink bombs or any other destructive items. The Crab Festival Committee will inform the vendor based on items identified in their application or will require vendor to stop selling the merchandise the day of the event if it is deemed inappropriate.
9. **Vendor Setup:** Set up time on Saturday, August 28 starts at 8:00AM. Vendors will be allowed to drive their vehicle in the booth area to set up and take down their booth. After the set up, all vehicles will have to be parked out of the area during the festival. Vendors will be directed to parking area.
10. **Vendor Fees:** •Food Booth - \$100.00 •Craft/Merchandise/Information Booth - \$50.00
