Preschool Baseball Sign ups

The Bridgeton Recreation Department will be offering Start Smart Sports Development Programs starting this month. These programs are part of the nonprofit National Alliance for Youth Sports. Among the sports being offered this year are an overall sports development program, baseball/tee ball, soccer, and basketball. Flag football and golf will also be available in the near future. The programs are all six weeks in duration and are offered to 3-5 year old boys and girls with a parent or guardian.

Starting April 30th, baseball/tee ball will begin. The Start Smart Baseball program targets parents who want to help their child develop basic motor skills such as throwing, catching, batting, running/agility that are needed to participate in organized baseball or softball. The program teaches the parents the proper way to develop those skills with their child while building their confidence.

“We are excited about being chosen to be a part of this national program,” said Melissa Hemple, Bridgeton Recreation Director. “This program is good for our community on so many levels. It provides parent -child quality time, children are exercising, it’s a nice feeder program for the tee ball programs in the area...I could go on and on”.

Applications will be accepted on a first come, first serve basis. There are limitations on the class size, so please do not delay in returning your application. Application deadline: April 22nd.

Baseball will start with a parent’s meeting on April 23rd at 6pm at the All Sports Museum of Southern NJ multipurpose room (Babe Ruth Dr. & Burt St). The cost is \$45 which includes equipment, participant manual and workbook.
